



SWINDON SINGING WORKSHOPS

The launch of Sing Up, the National Singing Programme in Swindon held at Lydiard House, Swindon. Wednesday 28th January, 2009.

The event is open to any one involved in singing with primary aged children whether in the community or at school. The event is free.

There are three trainers:

- Lin Marsh, one of the countries leading vocal educators, who will be teaching some new repertoire for Key Stage 1 and 2, including some warm ups to help develop singing skills and to build confidence (afternoon workshop). Performance and Presentation skills for children's singing groups (evening workshop).
- Dave Camlin, Creative Director of Sound Wave in Cumbria, will be running workshops (both afternoon and evening) on vocal arranging for use with children. He will also be teaching ways into song writing with children and improvisation techniques.
- Jacki Pattenden, a well known Swindon based singing trainer, will be running workshops on the 'Singing Steps' using the Voices Foundation model (afternoon workshop). Starting a children's choir, which will include practical advice, guidance and learning about suitable material to use with children (evening workshop).
